სახელმძღვანელო შეესაბამება ეროვნული სასწავლო გეგმით გათვალისწინებულ დ.3 საფეხურის მოთხოვნებს. მასში წარმოდგენილი სახალისო ტექსტები და ილუსტრაციები ხელს უწყობს მოსწავლეთა აქტიურ მონაწილეობას სწავლების პროცესში. ეს სახელმძღვანელო საშუალებას აძლევს მოსწავლეებს დაეუფლონ როგორც დამოუკიდებლად, ასევე წყვილად და ჯგუფთან ერთად მუშაობის უნარ ჩვევების ელემენტებს. ავტორების მიერ შემოთავაზებული საგანმანათლებლო თამაშები ზრდის მოსწავლეთა მოტივაციას, ხელს უწყობს შემოქმედებითი აზროვნების განვითარებას.

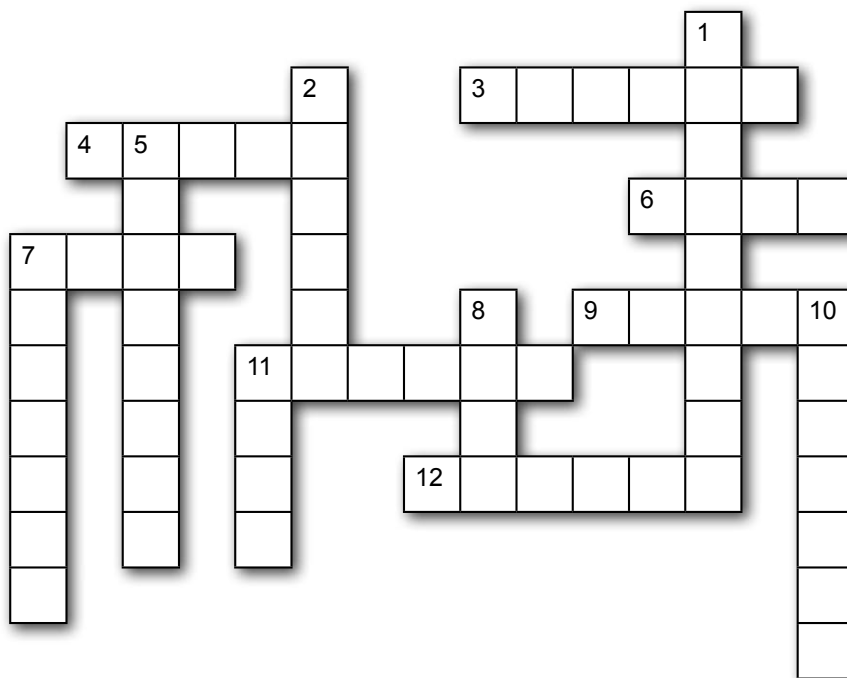

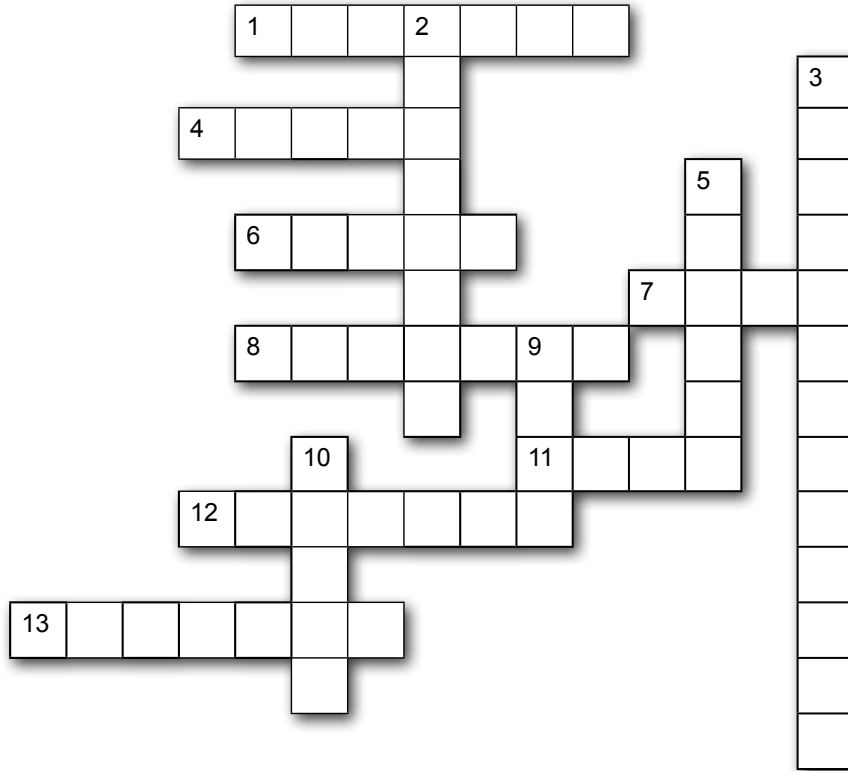
